

2010 Academy Awards® Street and Sidewalk Closures

21 days Prior to Show (Sunday, February 14, 2010):

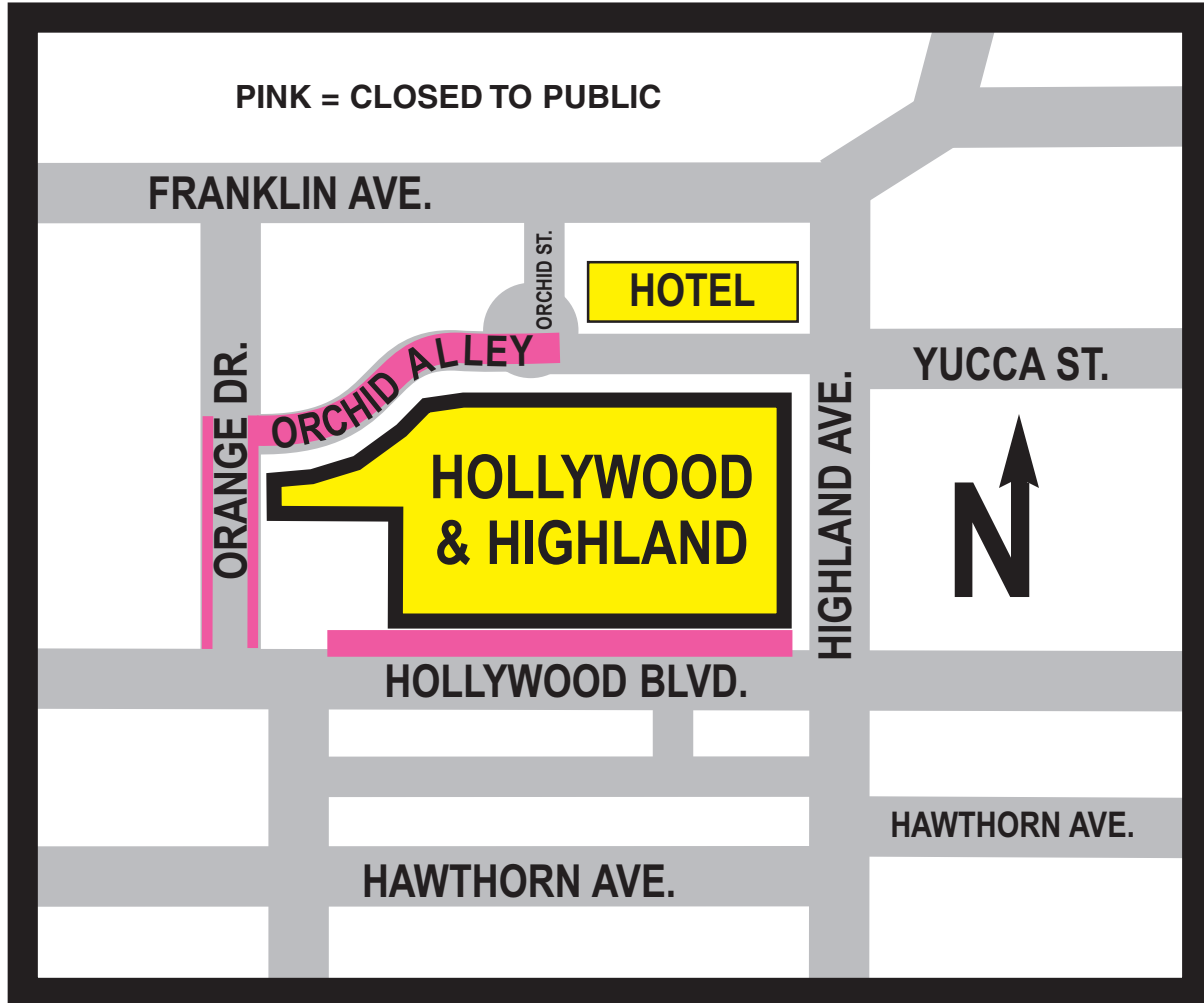
1. Close Orchid Alley from Orange Drive to Orchid Street from 8:00 AM to 8:00 AM on Saturday, March 13, 2010, except for emergency vehicles.

14 Days Prior to Show (Sunday, February 21, 2010):

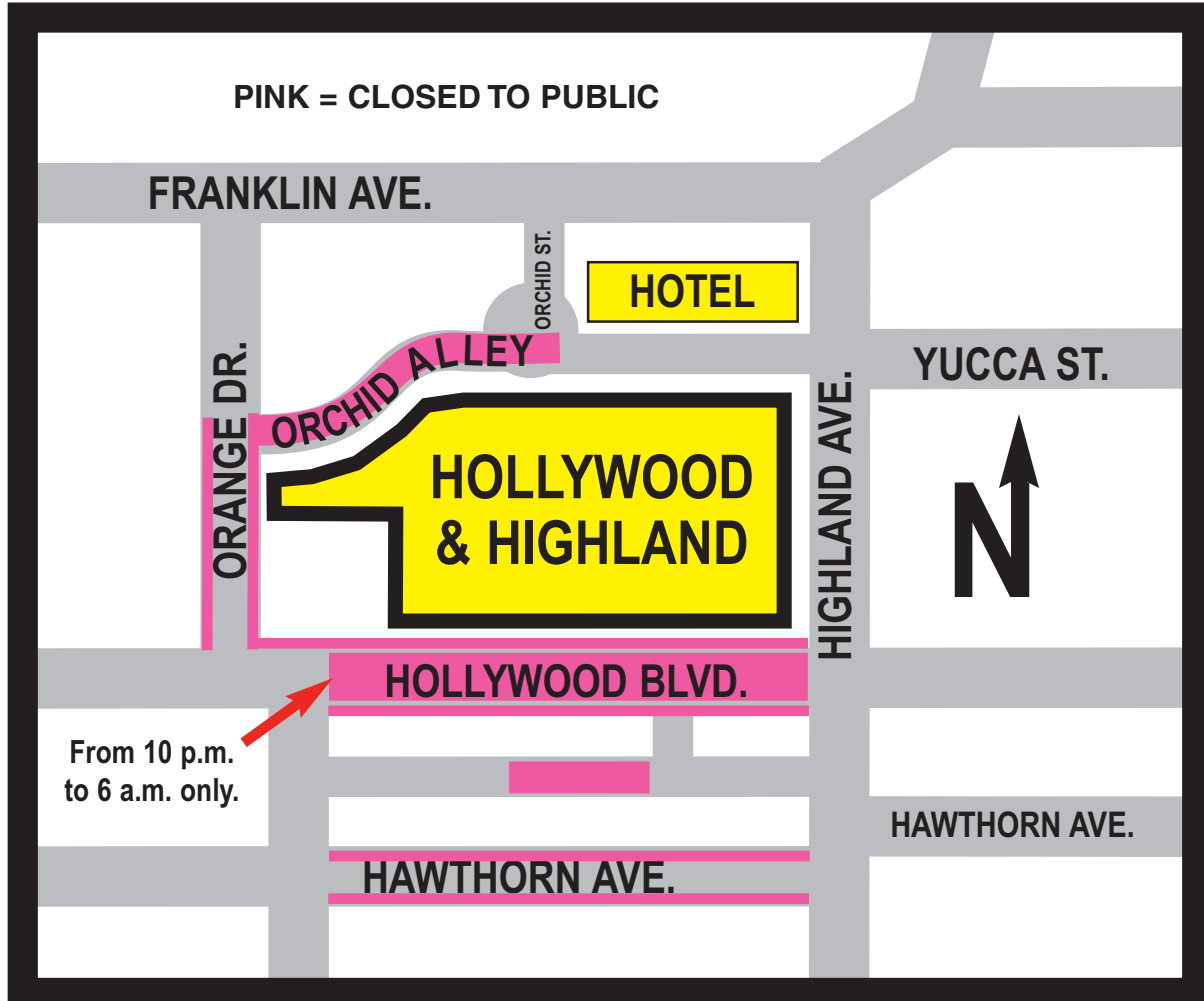
1. Close north curb lane of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to south east corner of Orange Drive from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM Tuesday, March 9, 2010. (Except MTA buses until February 28, 2010)
2. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 230 feet east of Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM Tuesday, March 9, 2010.
3. Close east and west curb lanes on Orange Drive from Hollywood Boulevard to Orchid Alley from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM Tuesday, March 9, 2010.



2010 Academy Awards® Street and Sidewalk Closures

7 Days Prior to Show (Sunday, February 28, 2010):

1. Close south sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM Tuesday, March 9, 2010, except 8-foot pedestrian access.
2. Close Hollywood Boulevard from the southeast corner of Orange Drive to Highland Avenue, from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 1, 2010.
3. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard in front of the Kodak Theatre portal from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Tuesday, March 9, 2010. This is a complete sidewalk closure in front of the entrance to Awards Walk. Pedestrian traffic re-routed and emergency access available.
4. Close balance of north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Tuesday, March 9, 2010.
5. Close the pedestrian crosswalk, mid-block on Hollywood Boulevard between Orange Drive and Highland Avenue, from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM on Tuesday, March 9, 2010.
6. Close north and south curb lanes of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Tuesday, March 9, 2010. MTA to re-route bus traffic. School buses exempt through the end of the school day on Friday, March 5, 2010.
7. Close Hawthorn Alley behind El Capitan Theatre from 300 feet east of Orange Drive east to the “T” alley from 10:00 PM. to 6:00 AM on Tuesday, March 9, 2010. The remainder of Hawthorn Alley to remain open from the “T” east to Highland Avenue.

6 Days Prior to Show (Monday, March 1, 2010):

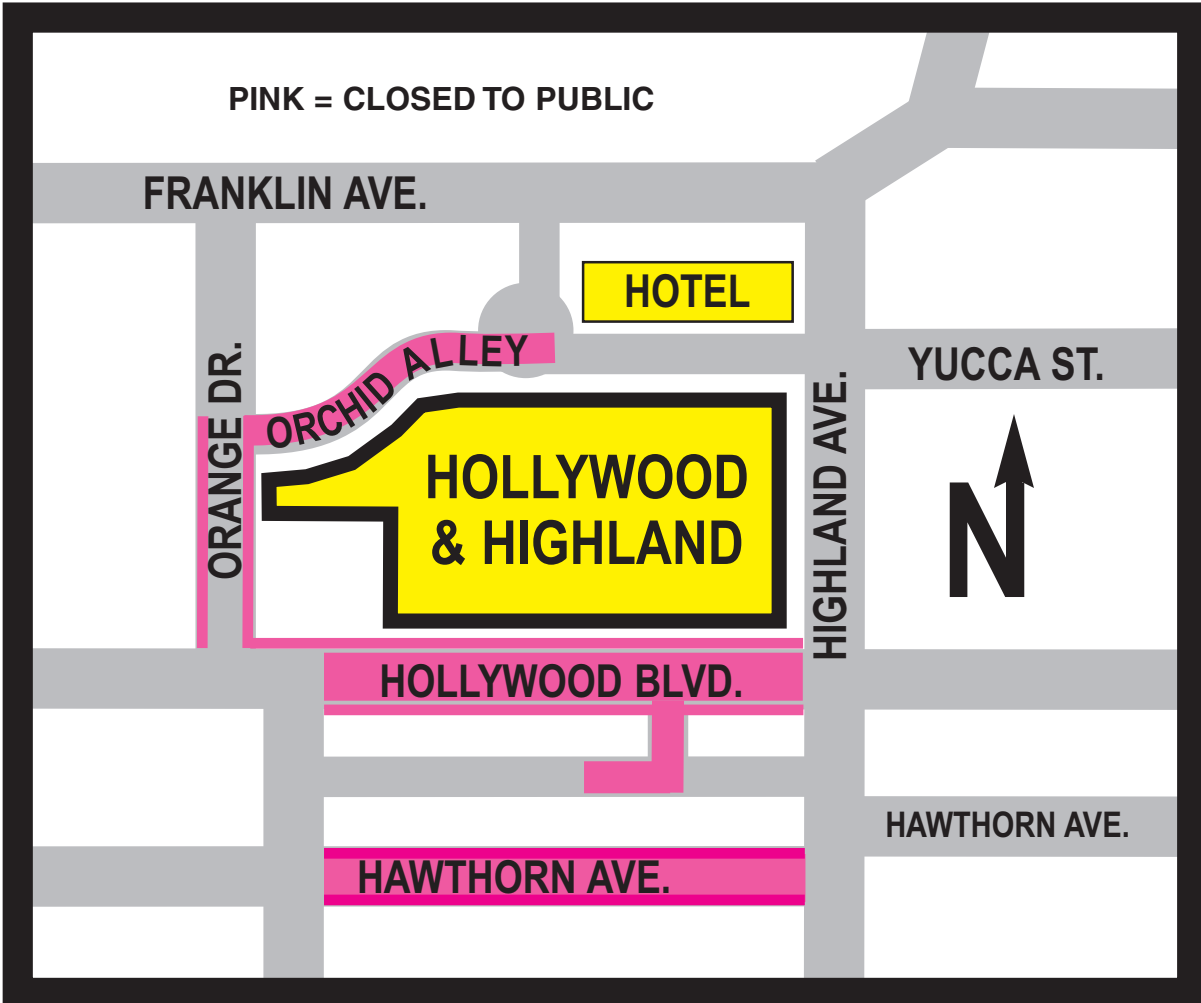
1. Close all lanes of Hollywood Boulevard from the southeast corner of Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Tuesday, March 9, 2010.
2. Close Hawthorn Alley on the east side of the El Capitan Theatre from Hollywood Boulevard south 210 feet to "T" of east/west alley from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Tuesday, March 9, 2010.

2 Days Prior to Show (Friday, March 5, 2010):

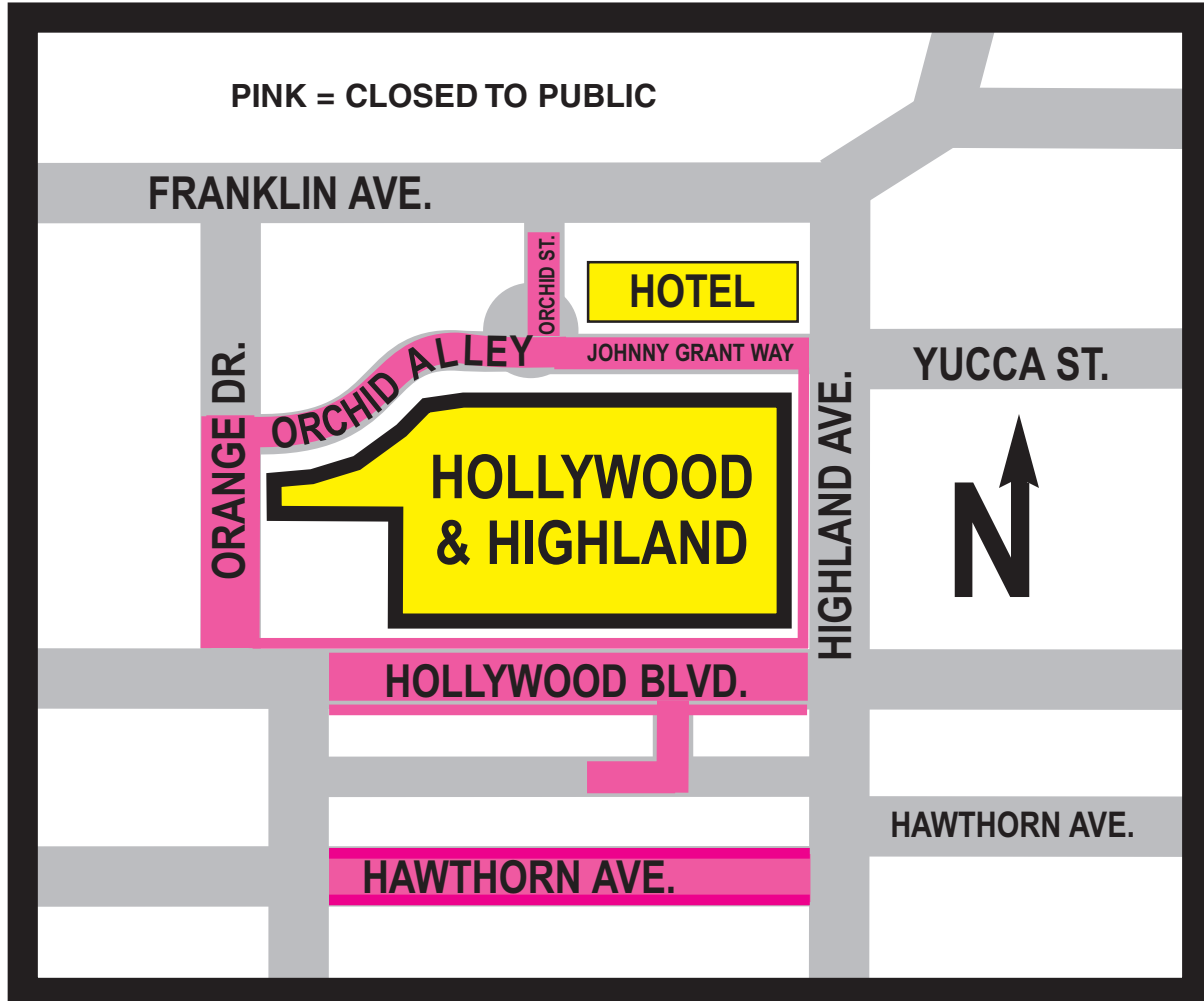
1. Close Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010. School busses allowed on Friday only.

1 Day Prior to Show (Saturday, March 6, 2010):

1. Close Orchid Street from 60 feet south of Franklin Boulevard to Orchid Alley from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010 except for residents, emergency vehicles, and hotel loading.
2. Close Orange Drive from Orchid Alley to Hollywood Boulevard, from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010 except for local residents, local business access, and emergency vehicles.
3. Close north and south sidewalk of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010.
4. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010. MTA station to be by-passed from the last regularly scheduled train on Saturday, March 6 until the first scheduled train after 6:00 AM on Monday, March 8, 2010. Pedestrian traffic rerouted to south sidewalk.
5. Close west sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Johnny Grant Way south to Hollywood Boulevard from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010.
6. Close Johnny Grant Way from Highland Avenue to Orchid Street from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010.

Day of Show (Sunday, March 7, 2010):

1. Close remainder of Hawthorn Alley from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010.
2. Close Orange Drive from Hawthorn Avenue to Hollywood Boulevard from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010.
3. Close south sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010 except for 8-foot pedestrian access. Erect bike rack.
4. Close north and south crosswalks on Hollywood Boulevard at the Highland Avenue intersection from 4:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010.
5. Close south sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard directly in front of the north-south running Hawthorn Alley from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010. Erect fencing along the entire sidewalk. No pedestrian access to cross alley.
6. Close east sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Hollywood Boulevard to Hawthorn Avenue from 12:01 AM to 6:00 A.M. Monday, March 8, 2010 except for 8-foot pedestrian access. Erect bike rack.
7. Close west sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Hollywood Boulevard south to Hawthorn Avenue from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010 except for 8-foot pedestrian access. Erect bike rack and fencing.
8. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue in front of closed businesses from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010. Erect bike rack.
9. Erect bike rack on the east curb of Highland Avenue from Hollywood Boulevard to the alley north of Hollywood Boulevard from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010.
10. Close east sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Yucca Street south to the alley from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 8, 2010 except for 8-foot pedestrian access.
11. Close southbound 101-freeway off-ramp at Highland.
12. Restricted access on streets that end at or intersect Hollywood Boulevard and Highland Avenue at the discretion of the LAPD and LADOT.
