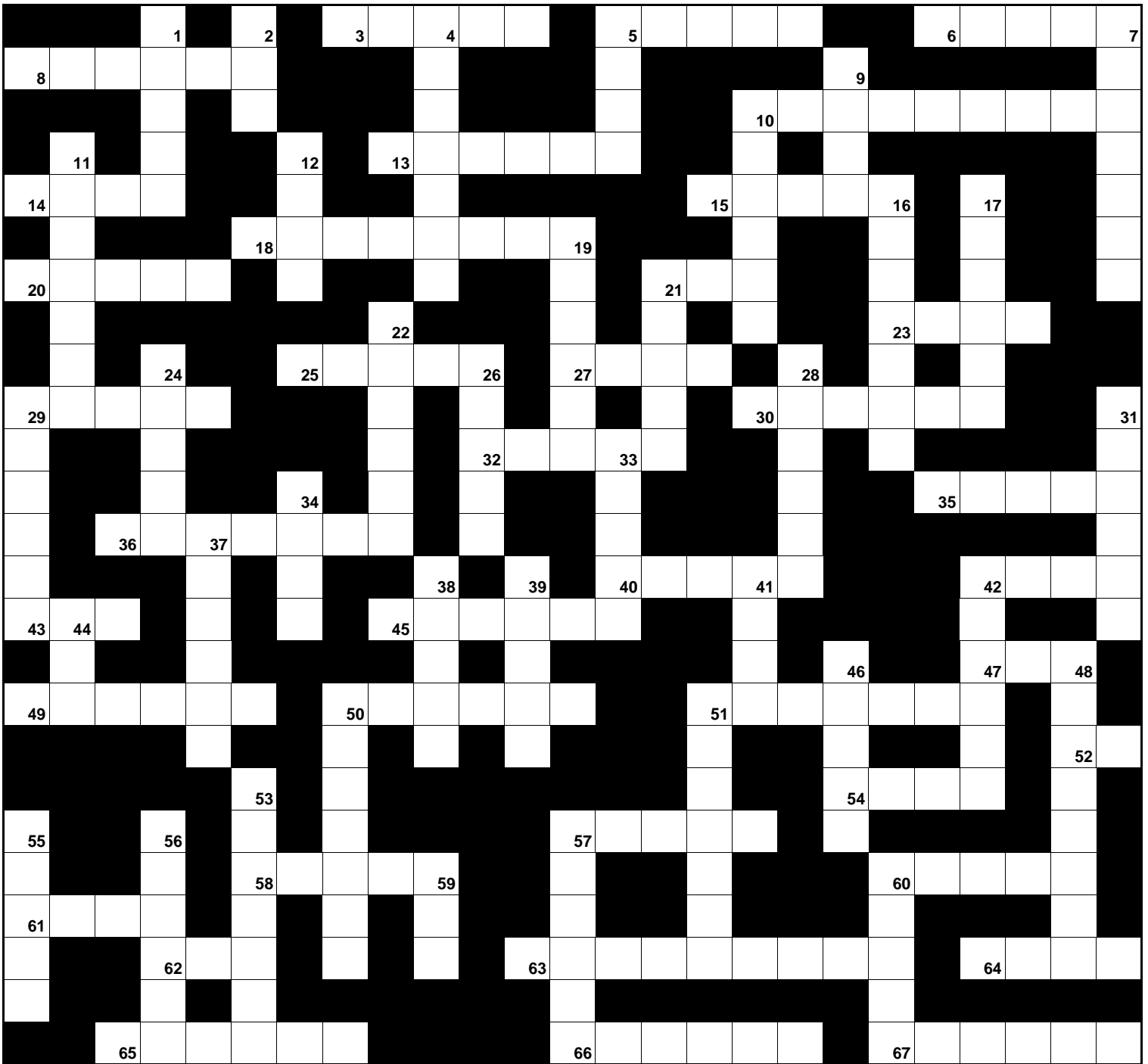


# Oscar Crossword Puzzle
