


21 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 11, 2018):


Close Orchid Alley from Orange Drive to Orchid Avenue from 8:00 AM to 8:00 AM on Saturday, March 10, 2018, except for emergency vehicles.





14 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2018):


- 1. Close north curb lane of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to south east corner of Orange Drive from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018. (Except MTA buses until Sunday, February 25, 2018)
- 2. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 230 feet east of Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018.
- 3. Close east and west curb lanes on Orange Drive from Hollywood Boulevard to Orchid Alley from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM Tuesday, March 6, 2018.





12 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 20, 2018):


Close all lanes of Hollywood Boulevard from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, February 21, 2018





11 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 21, 2018):

1. Close north curb lane of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018. MTA to re-route bus traffic.






7 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2018):

Due to Disney closure west of Orange Drive, close westbound lanes of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland to Orange.


- 1. Close south sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018, except 8-foot pedestrian access.
- 2. Close all lanes of Hollywood Boulevard (with 20-ft. Fire Lane) from the southeast corner of Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018.
- 3. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard in front of the Dolby Theatre portal from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018. This is a complete sidewalk closure in front of the entrance to Awards Walk. Pedestrian traffic re-routed and emergency access available.
- 4. Close balance of north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018.
- 5. Close the pedestrian crosswalk, mid-block on Hollywood Boulevard between Orange Drive and Highland Avenue, from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM on Wednesday, March 7, 2018.
- 6. Close south curb lane of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018. MTA to re-route bus traffic.





6 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (MONDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2018):


Close Hawthorn Alley on the east side of the El Capitan Theatre from Hollywood Boulevard south 210 feet to "T" of east/west alley from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 7, 2018.





2 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (FRIDAY, MARCH 2, 2018):


Close Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 5, 2018.





1 DAY PRIOR TO SHOW (SATURDAY, MARCH 3, 2018):

- 1. Close Orchid Avenue from 60 feet south of Franklin Boulevard to Orchid Alley from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 5, 2018 except for residents, emergency vehicles, and hotel loading.
- 2. Close Orange Drive from Orchid Alley to Hollywood Boulevard from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 5, 2018. Exception for local residents, local business access, and emergency vehicles.
- 3. Close north and south sidewalk of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 5, 2018.
- 4. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 5, 2018. MTA station to be by-passed from the last regularly scheduled train on Saturday, March 3 until the first scheduled train after 6:00 AM on Monday, March 5, 2018. Pedestrian traffic rerouted to south sidewalk.
- 5. Close west sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Johnny Grant Way south to Hollywood Boulevard from 10:00 PM to 9:00 AM Monday, March 5, 2018.
- 6. Close Johnny Grant Way from Highland Avenue to Orchid Avenue from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 5, 2018.





DAY OF SHOW (SUNDAY, MARCH 4, 2017):

12:01 am March 4 – 6 am March 5, close:

- 1. Remainder of Hawthorn Alley from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue.
- 2. Orange Drive from Hollywood Boulevard to Lanewood Avenue.
- 3. North sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue. Erect bike rack.
- 4. South sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue, except for 8-foot pedestrian access. Erect bike rack.
- 5. South sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard directly in front of the north-south running Hawthorn Alley. Erect fencing along the entire sidewalk. No pedestrian access to cross alley.
- 6. East sidewalk and curb lane of Highland Avenue from Yucca Street to Sunset Blvd from except for 8-foot pedestrian access. Erect bike rack.
- 7. West sidewalk and curb lane of Highland Avenue from Johnny Grant to Sunset Blvd except for 8-foot pedestrian access. Erect bike rack and fencing.
- 8. West curb of Highland Avenue from Johnny Grant Way to Hollywood Blvd UNTIL 9:00 AM

From 4am March 4 - 4am March 5, close:

- 9. North and south crosswalks on Hollywood Boulevard at the Highland Avenue intersection.
- 10. Highland Avenue from Sunset Boulevard to Franklin Avenue.
- 11. Hollywood Boulevard from La Brea Boulevard to Orange Drive.
- 12. Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Cahuenga Boulevard.

With the exception of local residents, business access and emergency vehicles, close the following between 4am March 4 – 4am March 5:

- 13. Hawthorn Avenue between Orange Drive and La Brea Boulevard.
- 14. Hawthorn Avenue between Highland Avenue and McCadden Place.
- 15. McCadden Place between Yucca Street and Hollywood Boulevard.
- 16. Yucca Street between Highland Avenue and Wilcox Avenue
- 17. Wilcox Avenue between Sunset Blvd and Cahuenga Boulevard Restrict access on streets that end at or intersect Hollywood Boulevard and Highland Avenue at the discretion of the LAPD and LADOT.
