



Submission Requirements for Documentary Feature

For films being released between January 1 and August 31, the completed online submission and all other entry materials must be received by the Academy no later than **30 days after** the end of the qualifying release.

For films being released between September 1 and December 31, the completed online submission and all other entry materials must be received by the Academy by 5pm PT on **Tuesday, October 1, 2019**.

To submit your film, go to submissions.oscars.org to register and request access to the Feature Film categories. Once approved, you'll receive an automated email with instructions. Please note – in order for your film to be eligible in any other category, including Music, you must submit in both the Documentary Feature and General Entry categories when completing your online submission.

Please upload the following on the submission site:

- The Oscars Submission Form (OSF) signed by all directors and producers
- Complete cast and crew credits (the film's full opening and closing credits as they appear on screen)
- Confirmation letter from either:
 - a) the film festival confirming the film's qualifying festival award
 - OR
 - b) the Los Angeles and New York theaters confirming the completion of the qualifying runs including the projection format, release dates and screening times.
- Digital copy (scanned image or PDF) of the film's movie critic review(s) in either the LA Times, LA Weekly, NY Times or Time Out. Please ensure that the scan(s) show the publication name and date. Please note – this is only required for films that are qualifying through a theatrical release.

DVDs must be in individual white paper sleeves and must include the title, running time and director name only. No artwork, contact information, company name or film logo is acceptable on the DVD labels or sleeves.
