Due to the continuing and evolving COVID-19 situation, the Campaign Regulations for the 93rd Oscars as they pertain to the International Feature Film category during Phase 1 (the period prior to Nominations), have been updated as follows:

- Film companies may only send “Watch Now” notices to all Academy members that a film competing in the International Feature Film category is available to view on the Academy Screening Room.

As the International Feature Film award is not a branch specific category and has its own viewing requirements and voting procedures, any such notice must be sent to the entire membership and include language that states “Only members who have opted-in to participate in the International Feature Film category will have access to view this film.”

The rules stated above are subject to change at any time.
