

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS DOCUMENTARY FEATURE FILM

Films entering the Documentary Feature Film category must qualify between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022. All required entry materials must be received by the Academy no later than 5pm PT on October 03, 2022.

To submit, go to submissions.oscars.org to register and request access to the Documentary Feature category. Once approved, you'll receive an automated email with instructions. If you are an Academy member or have submitted in the past, you do not need to register an account to login.

SUBMISSION FORMS
☐ The Oscars Submission Form (OSF). This is created at the submission site and must signed by all
directors, producers, and designated nominees.
☐ A copy of the complete cast and crew credits . Acceptable formats are PDF, Word, or Excel.
Typically, the complete credits include production and releasing companies and all cast and crew
(such as producers, directors, designers) appearing in the front and end of the film. Ideally the OSF
and the opening and end credits are uploaded at the same time.
☐ Confirmation document(s) for ONE of the following:
a) Confirmation of the qualifying film festival award
OR
b) Letter from a commercial theater in a qualifying metro area confirming the completion of the
weeklong theatrical run. Projection format, release dates, and screening times should be
included on the documentation. If the movie's theatrical run is to occur after the October 3
submission deadline, a theatrical booking confirmation document must be submitted prior.
MATERIALS FOR THE ACADEMY SCREENING ROOM
Once your film has entered to the 95th Academy Awards, you are required to upload your film to the
Academy Screening Room (no fee).
