

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS LIVE ACTION SHORT FILM

Films entering the Live Action Short Film category must qualify between October 1, 2021 and September 30, 2022. All required entry materials must be received by the Academy no later than 5pm PT on October 14, 2022.

To submit, go to <u>submissions.oscars.org</u> to register and request access to the Short Films categories. Once approved, you'll receive an automated email with instructions. If you are an Academy member or have submitted in the past, you do not need to register an account to login.

SORMISSION FORMS
☐ The Oscars Submission Form (OSF). This is created at the submission site and must signed by all directors, producers, and designated nominees.
□ A copy of the complete cast and crew credits. Acceptable formats are PDF, Word, or Excel. Typically, the complete credits include production and releasing companies and all cast and crew (such as producers, directors, designers) appearing in the front and end of the film. Ideally the OSF and the opening and end credits are uploaded at the same time.
☐ Confirmation document(s) for ONE of the following:
a) Confirmation of the qualifying film festival award
<u>OR</u>
b) Letter from a commercial theater in a qualifying metro area confirming the completion of the
weeklong theatrical run. Projection format, release dates, and screening times should be
included on the documentation.
MATERIALS FOR THE ACADEMY SCREENING ROOM
Once your film has qualified for entry to the 95th Academy Awards, you are required to upload your film
in the Academy Screening Room (no fee).
